**Duration:** 3 or 6 Months (stipend available for some candidates)

### Tasks Include:

- Collating data on ecosystem impacts of the urban development corridor through the Blue Mountains World Heritage Area.
- Compiling this data for a large scale research project.
- Contacting government agencies, universities and other research facilities to gather relevant information.
- Creating a list of research projects to insert into a database.
- Creating a brief to include meta-analysis of the collation.
